CARY, N.C. – PMI Ash Technologies, LLC was recently awarded the Commonwealth of Virginia Governor's Award for Environmental Excellence. The winners of the award were announced by the Virginia Secretary of Natural Resources, L. Preston Bryant, Jr., on April 2 at the Environment Virginia 2008 conference in Lexington, Virginia.

The awards recognize the significant contributions of environmental and conservation leaders in three categories: environmental projects, environmental programs and land conservation. They are given to businesses and industrial facilities, government agencies and individuals.

PMI Ash Technologies was awarded the Silver Medal in the "Environmental Projects, Small Business" category for their Carbon Burn Out facility in Chesapeake, Virginia. The Chesapeake Energy Center Carbon Burn Out facility enables PMI Ash Technologies and Dominion Virginia Power to beneficially reuse fly ash that would otherwise be landfilled. The beneficiated fly ash is used as a partial replacement of Portland cement in concrete. The Carbon Burn Out facility also increases the efficiency of the power plant due to heat recovered through the beneficiation process.
